Remembering our Brethren

Stephen (34 AD) Doctrinally Stephen was the last in a series of rejections by the Jewish people. They had first rejected the Father, then the Son and then Stephen as representing the Holy Ghost - "being full of the Holy Ghost" (Acts 7:55). The testimony of his life was not the way he died, but what he was willing to do while he lived, to fully represent Jesus Christ. His life and words ended his earthly pilgrimage yet started his eternity in grand fashion - "and saw the Glory of God".
